“Cape Verde possesses the essentials for being a highly competitive Center for International Business, and a privileged space for the location of companies, headquarters of holding societies and for highly specialised independent professionals” (PEDS).

CIN-CV SA will have the following strategic business units (SBU):

1. International Business Centers:
 - this SBU will manage the running of the 3 international centers: Industrial International Center, Commercial International Center and Services International Center.
 - The main revenues for this SBU will be the licensing and running fees from the companies inside the 3 centers.
2. International Shipping Register of Cabo Verde
3. Promotion and Management of Parks
4. Tax-free Shops and *Duty-free*

CIN CV – FISCAL BENEFITS:

Low IRPC taxes (income tax over corporate bodies) regarding income originated from the practice of activities of industrial or commercial nature, and its accessory or complementary activities, as well as of services:

International Center of Industry and International Center of Trade:

- 5% for entities with five or more dependent workers;
- 3,5% for entities with twenty or more dependent workers;
- 2.5% for entities with fifty or more dependent workers;

International Center of Service Rendering:

- 2.5% for entities with four or more dependent workers.
